

EERI-NYNE Earthquake Brief May 29, 2015

This is a periodic briefing on Gorkha, Nepal Earthquake prepared by EERI-NYNE (New York – Northeast Chapter of the Earthquake Engineering Research Institute), in collaboration with regional organizations, with news on engineering reconnaissance, humanitarian assistance and technical aspects.

STATUS as of 5/7/15 (Actionaid.org)

Death toll has risen to 7,652 with the count of injuries reaching to 14,556.

191,058 homes are leveled to surface while 175,162 homes sustained partial damage.

10,718 government buildings are destroyed and 14,741 buildings were damaged partially.

Estimated 8 million people are affected by the earthquake and 2.8 million people being displaced.
